Here's a short checklist of items seniors need to complete before graduation: Career Portfolio – this is a graduation requirement. • Complete and submit the portfolio for review. - Sign up for new student orientation/registration at the college. • Submit your FAFSA (if you have not already done so).

- Keep applying for scholarships.

- Start applying for jobs...check out local newspapers.

- Set up a time to meet with a staffing agency, such as Flexstaff

- Attend Job Fairs.

- Visit Fox Cities Workforce Development.
