



Youth Options

Elective or required

Grade: 11-12

Length: One semester

Credit: .25 high school credit for each 1 credit of post-secondary course

(Example: .75 high school credit for a 3 credit post-secondary course)

The Youth Options program allows all public high school juniors and seniors, who meet certain requirements, to take post-secondary courses at a UW institution, a Wisconsin technical college, one of the state's participating private, non-profit, institutions of higher education, or via satellite in the high school distance learning lab. The purpose for participating in this program would be to take one or more college courses not comparable to HHS courses. Students receive high school and/or college credit. To qualify for this program, students must be in good standing here both academically and in discipline/attendance, and meet the criteria and timelines established by the post-secondary institution. The fall semester deadline is March 1st. The spring semester deadline is October 1st. **See the school counselor if interested in applying.**
